Some countries (e.g. the USA) have a llCriminal Codell, which puts most/all of their criminal offences together into a single document. Scotland doesn't have one. A crime (or lloffence!) in Scotland can be put into one of two broad categories: common law offences and statutory offences.

A jury in a Scottish criminal case is made up of 15 people and returns a verdict of guilty where at least eight of its members support that verdict. This level of support is required whether the jury has a full complement of 15 or is reduced in numbers (eg because one or more jurors have been excused).
