Quiet Room is a collection of Zen poetry by 14th century Zen master Jakushitsu—widely considered to be one of the finest poets of the genre. He finds one room is haunted by a troubled young woman. Through a series of midnight psychotherapy sessions a strong bond develops between them, complicating David's real-life relationship. In the end he must choose between Angela and Almira, the ghostly object of his desire. The supporting 1840s story is being told as a gothic romance. In a world of strict classes and forbidden desires.
